

UPDATED GUIDE FOR SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING AT HOME

What can I recycle through the new single-stream system?

Place all of the following items in your recycling bin

- Paper (newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, envelopes, books (hardcovers & binding removed)) - No bundling required!
- Phone books
- Clean cardboard and boxboard (cracker, cookie, pasta, shoe boxes and other similar materials) – No bundling required!
- Aseptic packaging (milk cartons, juice boxes, broth boxes)
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Office & school papers (even shredded paper)
- Empty glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum cans, pie pans, and clean foil
- Empty tin and steel cans including aerosol cans (no paint, pesticide, herbicide containers)
- Metal pots & pans
- Metal hangers
- Plastic hangers
- Plastic caps & lids
- All plastic containers #1 & #2
- All other plastic food, beverage, soap, and shampoo containers #s 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7
- Plastic flower pots/plant containers
- Plastic toys (small)
- Plastic buckets, crates, laundry baskets

What is NOT recyclable in this system?

- No garbage/food waste/food tainted items/pizza boxes
- No yard waste
- No plastic bags
- No plastic utensils
- No Styrofoam
- No motor oil bottles
- No hazardous chemical containers
- No electronics/batteries
- No compact discs or DVDs
- No foam egg cartons
- No ice cream containers
- No light bulbs
- No medication bottles
- No Tyvek
- No wax or plastic coated cardboard
- No drinking glasses/china
