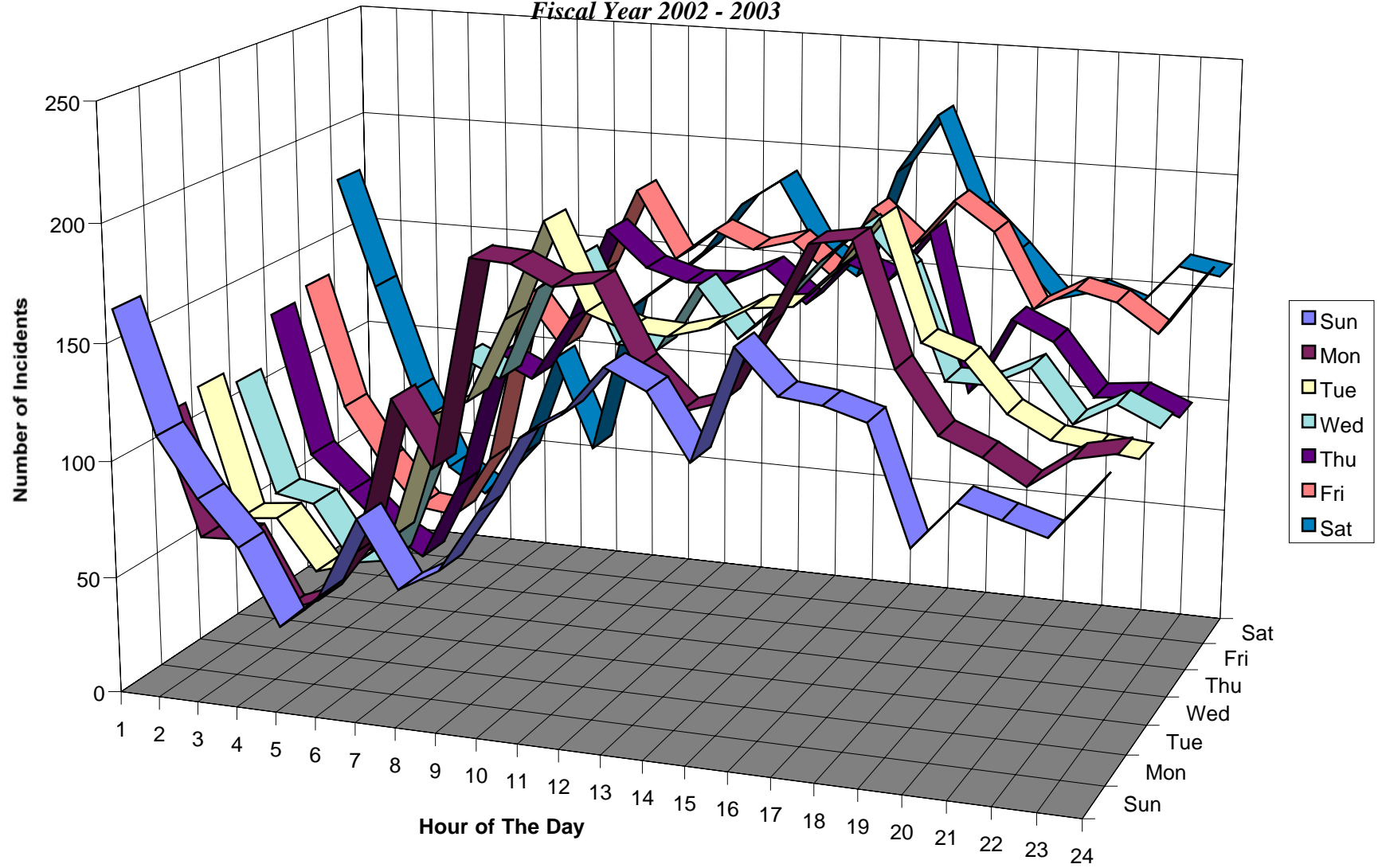

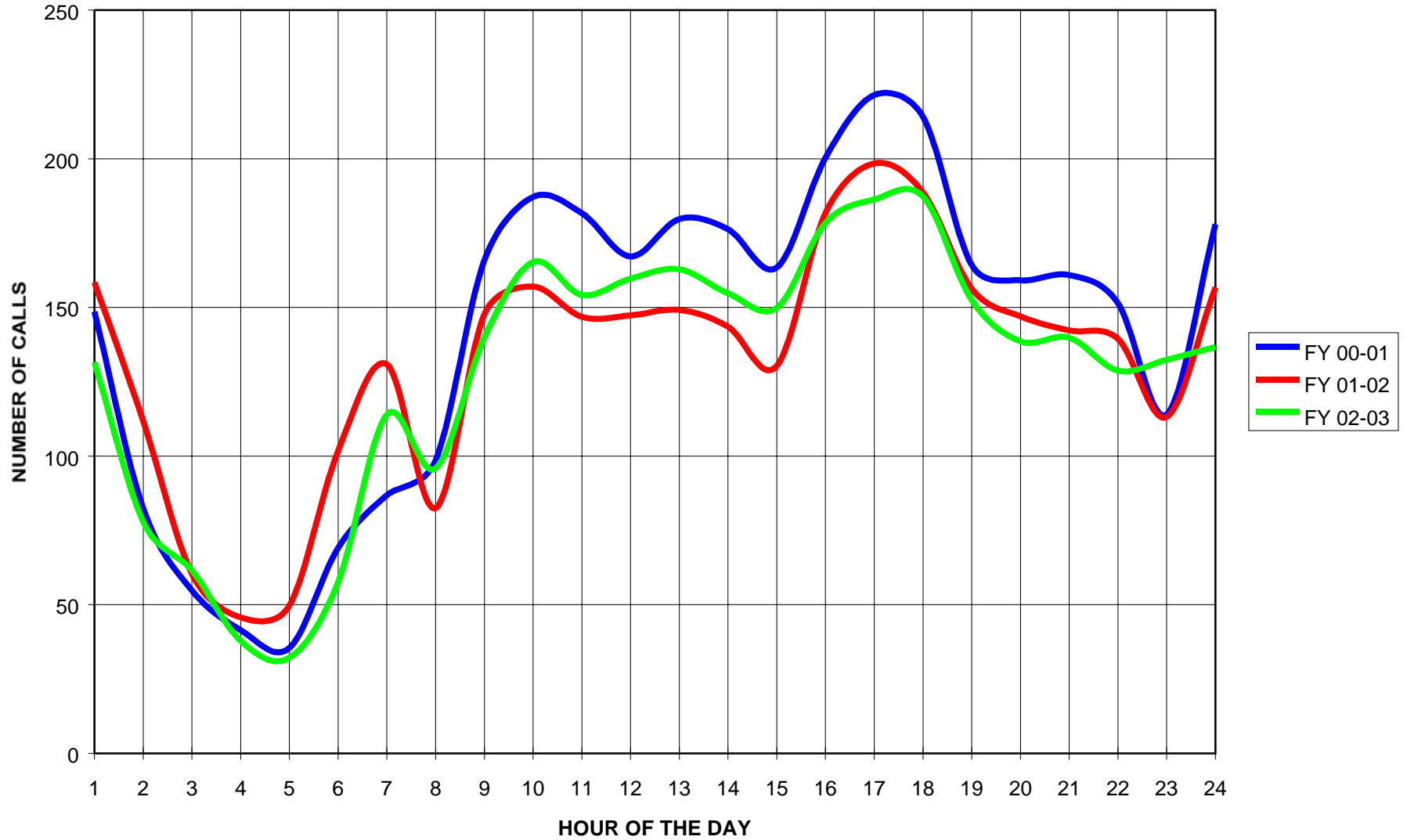

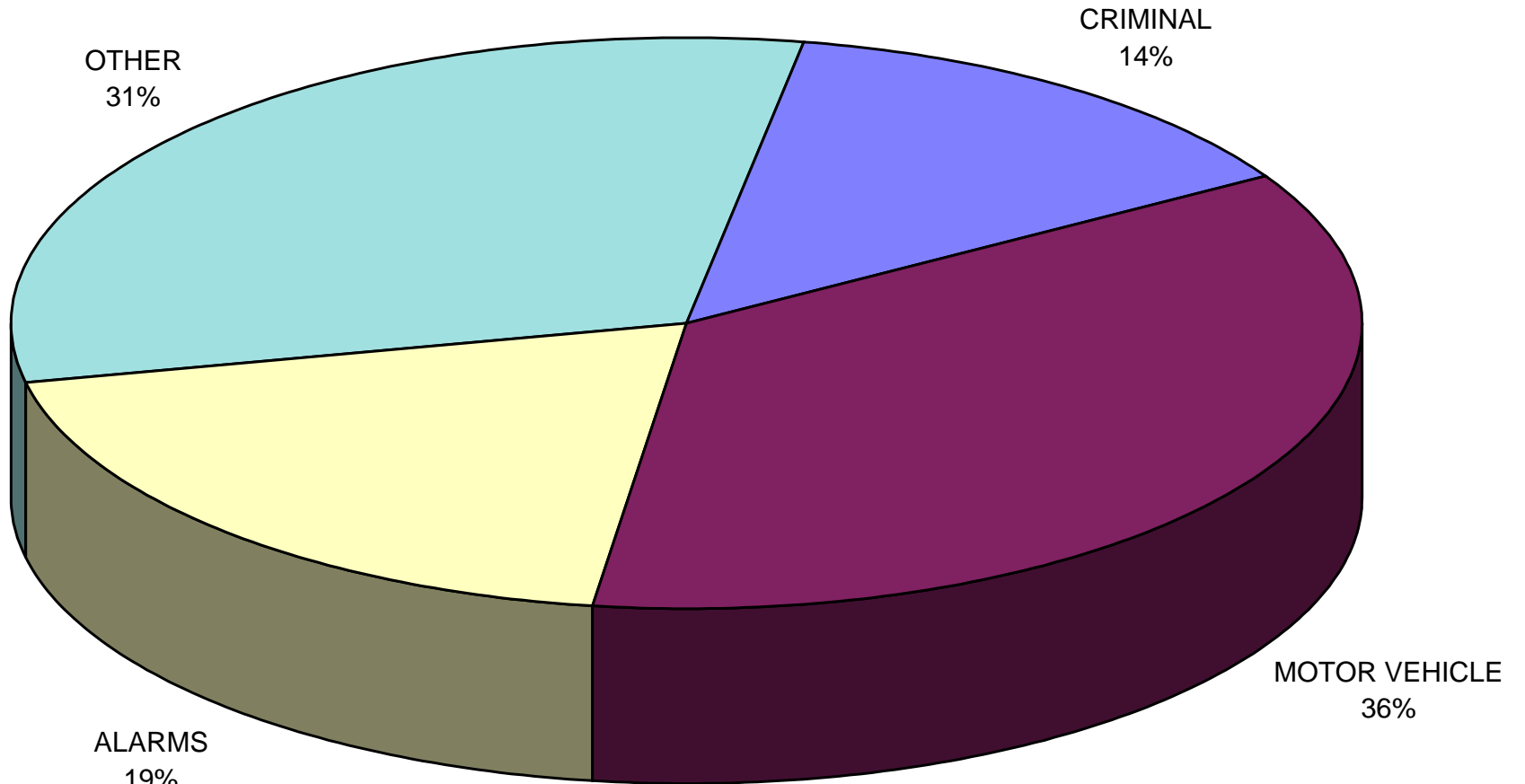

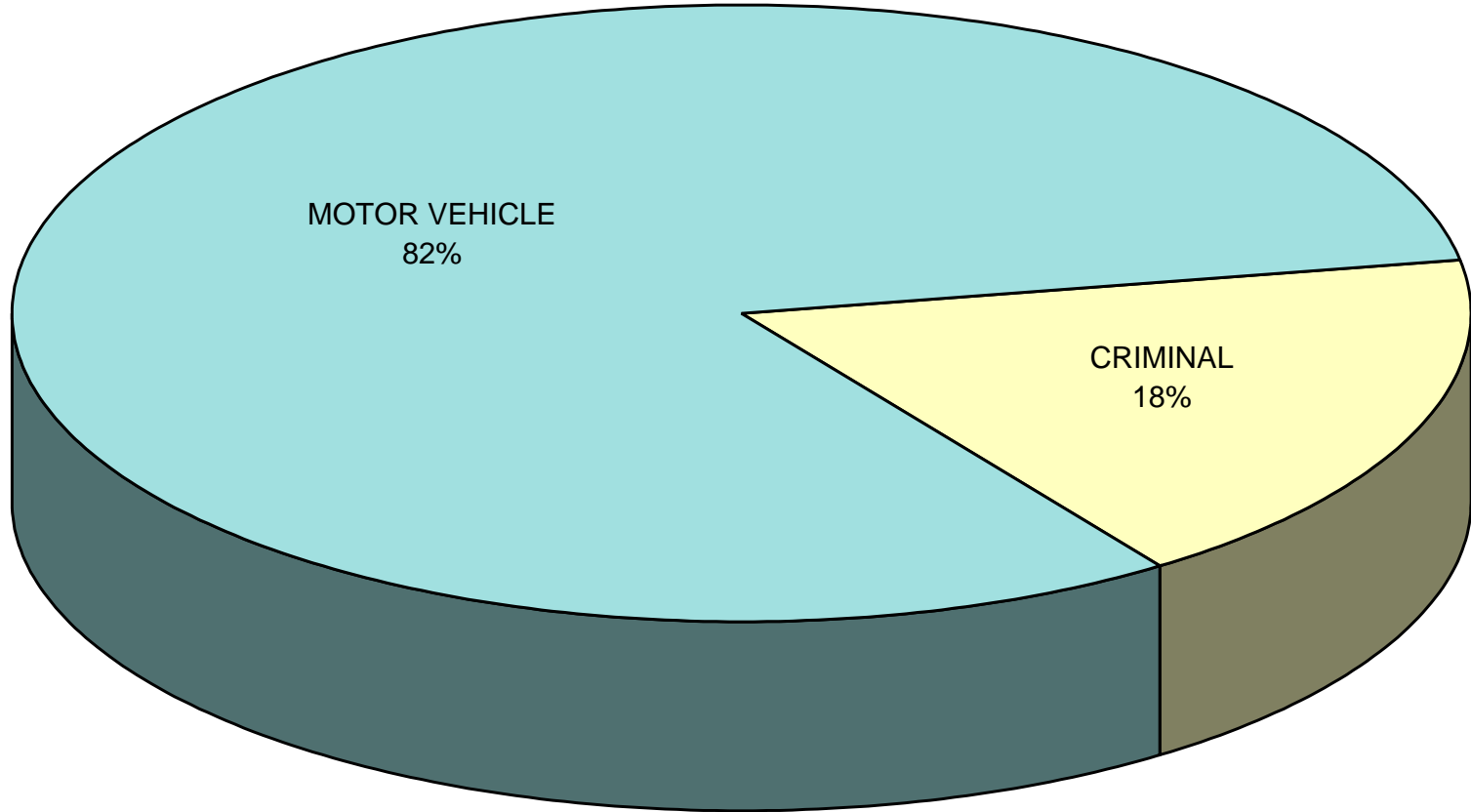

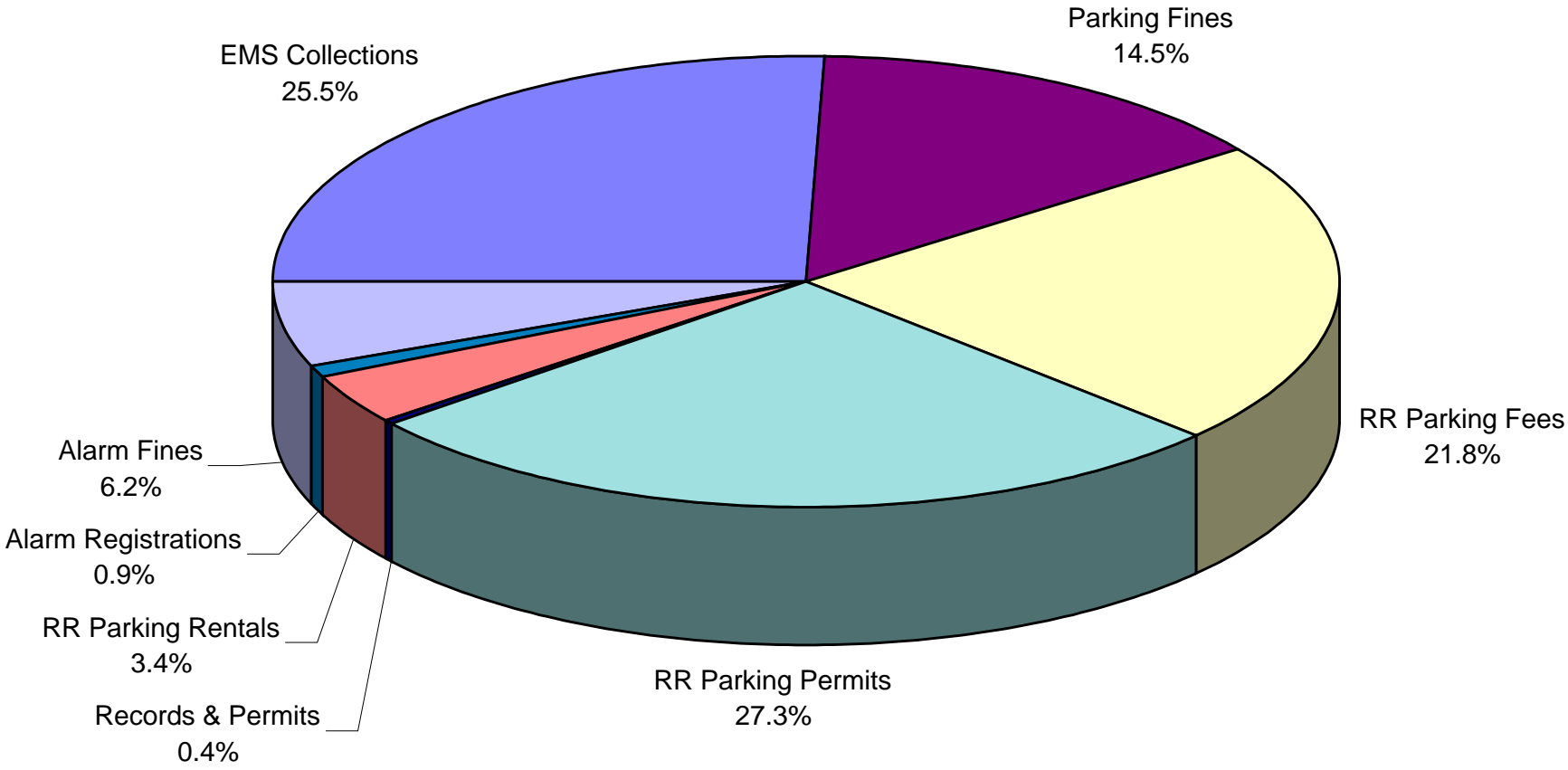

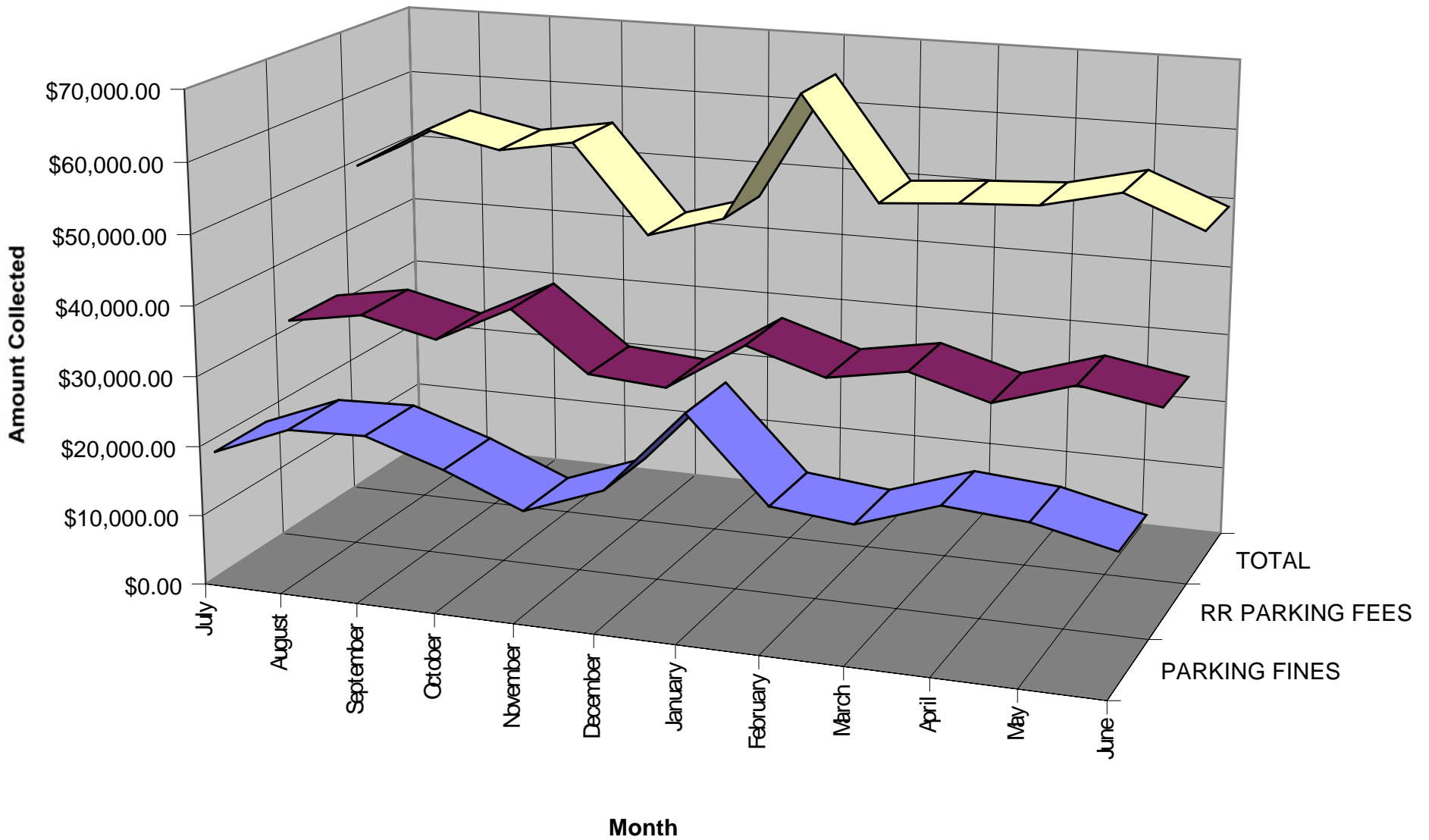

Revenue from Parking Tickets

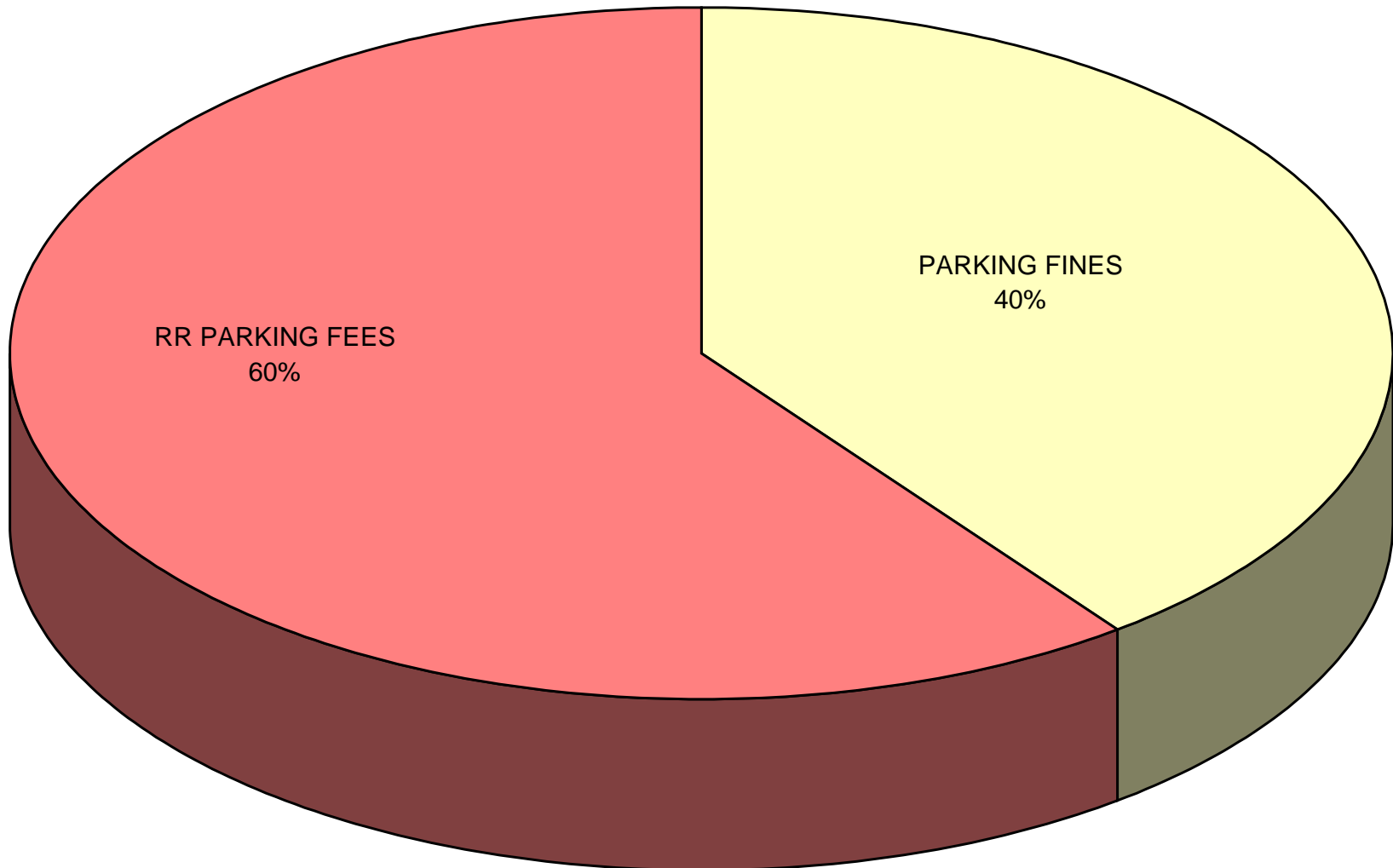

Division of Ticket Revenue

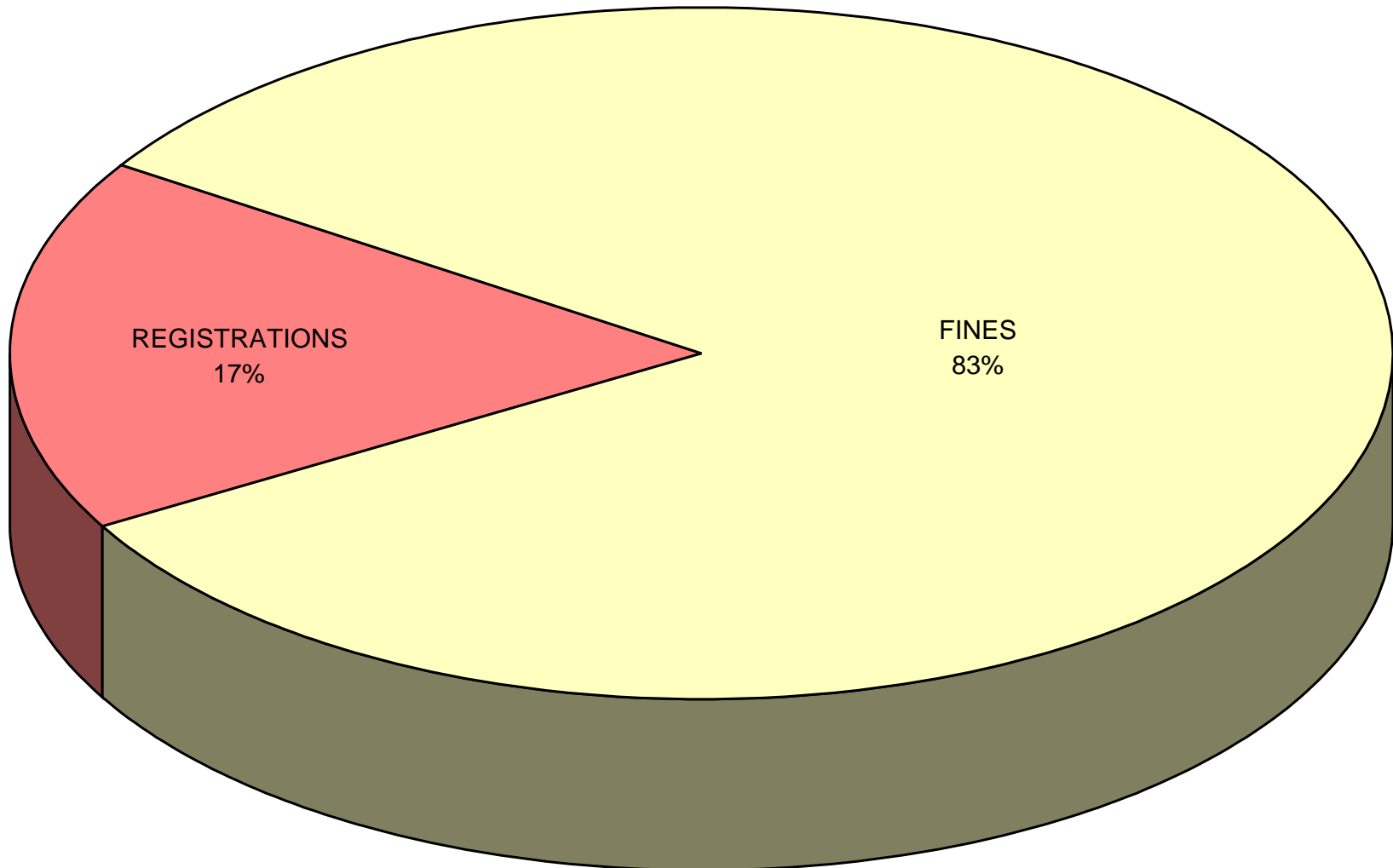
