Traffic Advisory for Monday, July 1, 2019

Due to severe afternoon storms on June 30, the Town suffered several road closures and downed power lines. As a result of power outages the traffic control signals are still not functional at the Sherwood Island Connector.

We continue to urge residents to stay home as the clean-up and repairs are conducted. If you must be on the road, please drive with caution and do not attempt to go around police tape and/or barricades.

All Town agencies are diligently working to alleviate these conditions in partnership with Eversource. At this time over 20 roads have been re-opened, and work will continue through the overnight hours.

Please be considerate of these conditions during your morning commute and allow for extra time as damage throughout the Town has been extensive.
