

3. Compo Marina: Report on issuance of a WPL/E for a seawall maintenance as a WPL/E.

Mr. Kelly stated that WPLO regulations allow for the Town Engineer and the Conservation Director to issue administrative approvals for certain projects. He reviewed the permit for repair of 810 linear feet of deteriorating seawall along Compo Beach Road. He reviewed the plans to replace the vertical wall with a sloped embankment design to better handle wave action and prevent catastrophic failure. The permit was issued on January 12, 2026. The work will be done in sections as required by the State.

4. Other Business

Mr. Kelly noted the upcoming January 28, 2026 Work Session. He stated Nathan Hartshorne will be presenting that Annual Report. Ted Gill, PE from the Engineering Department will discuss proposed changes to the WPL Ordinance. The changes focus on how the Flood Board functions within the WPLO. The changes will require RTM approval as this is a local ordinance.
