APPROVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF WESTPORT AND HOOK'D ON THE SOUND, LLC

1. Parks and Recreation Director Erik Barbieri presented Item #1. Mr. Barbieri provided background to the terms of the original agreement, the process of negotiations with the proprietors and the circumstances that prompted the request for a settlement. Further, Mr. Barbieri noted the plan to issue a Food and Beverage Concession RFP going forward as well as the potential arrangements to allow for available concessions during this upcoming season. Upon motion by Don O'Day, seconded by Kevin Christie, and passing by a vote of 2-0, it was:

RESOLVED, that the Settlement Agreement between the Town of Westport and Hook'd on the Sound LLC, which Agreement provides for an early termination to a Food and Beverage Concession lease dated August 27, 2020 for Compo Beach Pavilion, Halfway House, and the Longshore Pavilion Space is hereby APPROVED.
